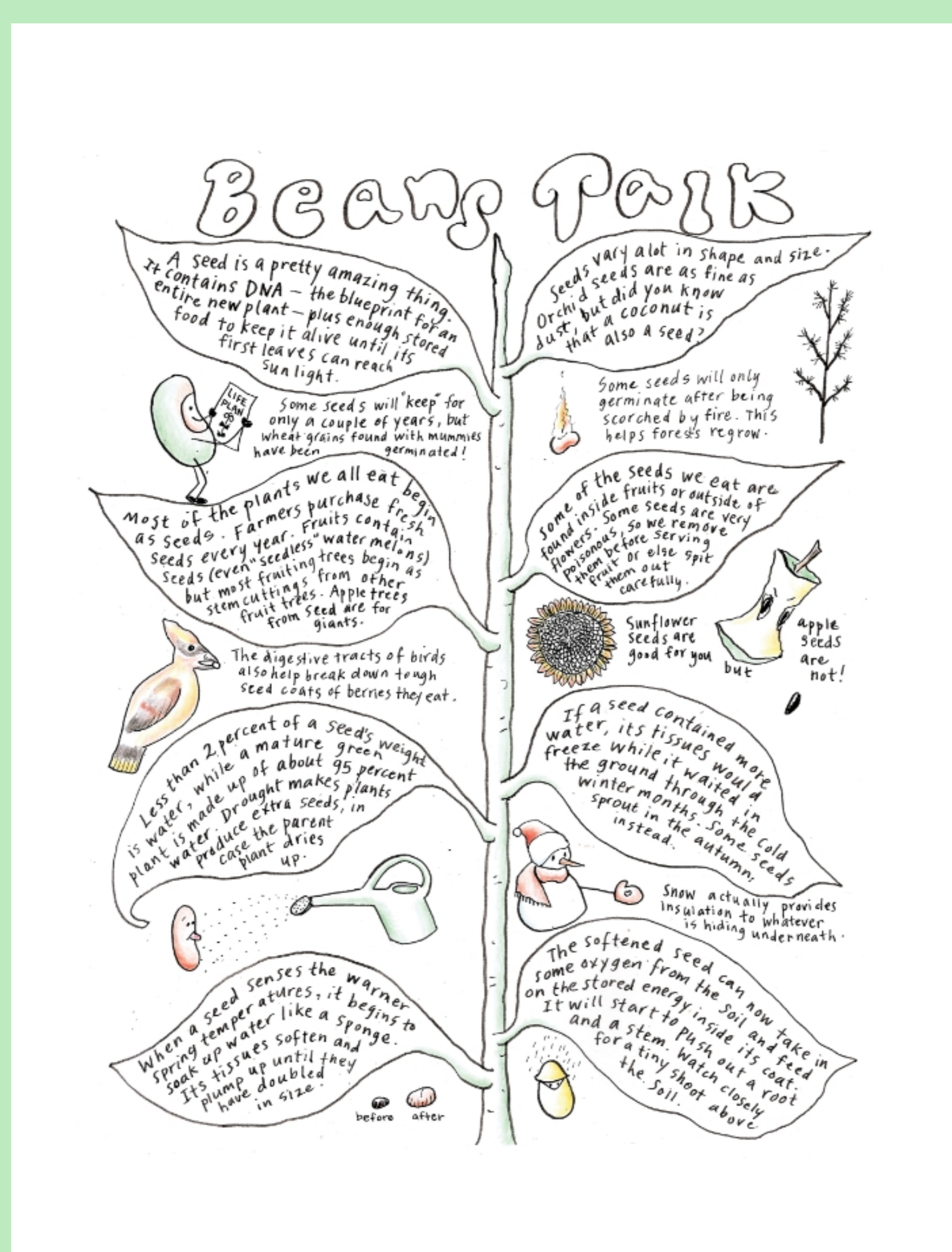
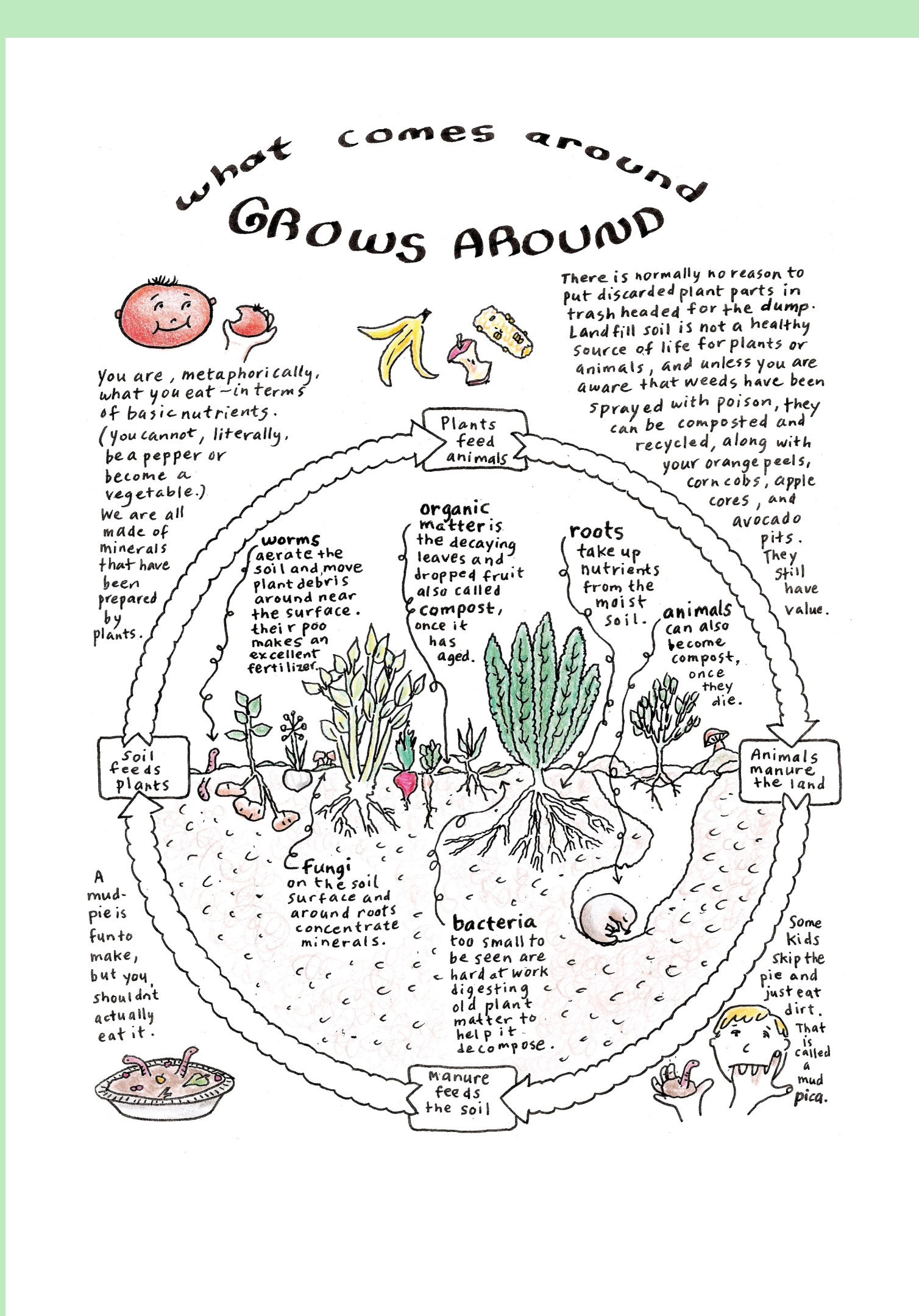
Picture A Garden
